Benefits and Services Manual

With Association Motor Plan (AMP), emergency roadside assistance is just a phone call away. Whether you have a flat tire, dead battery, or lock your keys in the car, help is available 24/7 anywhere you travel within the U.S., Canada, or Mexico.¹ Association Members also have access to additional services and benefits.

Emergency Roadside Assistance²

When the automobile, motorcycle or single rear-axle truck you are driving is disabled, call the dispatch number. A service provider will be dispatched to supply you with the necessary roadside assistance. "Sign & go" service is at no cost to you. Services are subject to a \$125 maximum coverage per disablement.

The Emergency Roadside Assistance benefit is limited to one service call per disablement for a service provided by a commercial garage, locksmith, or tow truck including:

- vehicle towing
- battery jump start
- winching
- fuel delivery (up to 2 gallons, except where prohibited by law)
- tire change
- lockout services
- delivery and installation of parts on vehicle at the disablement site

Tire change assistance is also available for a trailer you are pulling.

When the service provider arrives, you must present your membership card and driver's license and sign for the services rendered. You are responsible for paying the service provider for charges exceeding the \$125 maximum per disablement.
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There is no reimbursement for these charges.

If dispatch services are not used and you call the service provider of your choice, the program will reimburse you up to \$125 per disablement for the previously-mentioned services.

The Emergency Roadside Assistance benefit does not provide for the cost of a tire, battery, parts, gasoline, or service while at an auto repair shop or service station, or towing to another location. This is an emergency benefit and is not intended to underwrite any business expense or substitute for regular vehicle maintenance.

An emergency situation does not include installation or removal of chains or snow tires, service for an unlicensed vehicle, impounded vehicle, or a vehicle in an unsafe condition.

Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. reserves the right to refuse program services to any Association Member under the following conditions:

- i) material misrepresentation; or
- ii) excessive use of benefits.

Stolen Vehicle Reward

Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. will provide up to a \$5,000 reward when your vehicle is stolen. This reward:

- discourages theft of your vehicle
- encourages law enforcement action when your vehicle is stolen
- provides incentive to convict the thief who stole your vehicle

This reward will be paid to the law enforcement agency or person responsible for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the

thief. The reward will be based on the vehicle's current market value, not to exceed \$5000. The reward is not payable to the Association Member, the Association Member's family, or other persons listed on the membership. The reward does not cover vandalism or items stolen from inside your vehicle. When your vehicle is stolen, report the theft to local police and contact Member Services for a claim form.

² Emergency Roadside Assistance is limited to single rear-axle vehicles. Emergency Roadside Assistance does not cover acts of nature, such as flooding, hurricanes, or tornadoes. Association Members who are also owners, operators, or employees of a commercial garage, locksmith, or tow truck may not use that company to provide service for themselves or others on their membership. Neither Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. nor its affiliates is responsible for vehicle damage claims arising from your selected service provider.

Bail Bond³

Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. will arrange up to a \$2,000 bond to release an Association Member when you are driving a vehicle and are charged with a moving traffic law violation such as:

- speeding
- manslaughter
- negligent homicide

Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. does not arrange bonds for non-moving traffic law violations, parking, hit and run, any drug- or alcohol-related charges, driving without a valid driver's license, fines, or arrest made pursuant to any warrant.

Call 800-567-5015 - 24 hours a day, seven days a week - to obtain a bond. Association Members will be responsible for reimbursing Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. for bond forfeitures.

Attorney's Fees⁴

Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. will reimburse you for expenses incurred to retain the attorney of your choice up to:

- \$200 to represent you for a speeding charge or other moving traffic law violations
- \$500 for injuries received by you in a multi-vehicle accident or damages when your vehicle is damaged by another vehicle⁵
- \$2,000 to defend you when you are in a vehicle accident and are charged with negligent homicide or manslaughter⁶

Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. does not pay fines, court costs, or attorney's fees for license, parking, or other non-moving traffic law violations, appeals, retainers, hit and run, or any drug- or alcohol-related charges. When you hire an attorney, contact Member Services for a claim form.

Travel Assistance Reimbursement⁷

Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. will reimburse you up to \$250 per member, \$500 per incident for vehicle rental and travel expenses when you are driving or riding in a vehicle that is disabled due to a collision accident that occurs when you are 100 miles or more away from home.

This reimbursement can be used for expenses incurred in the first 7 days after the date of the accident for:

- meals
- hotel or motel lodging
- airline, bus, or train tickets
- vehicle rental expense (up to 7 days when you rent from a licensed vehicle rental agency within 30 days of the accident date. Gas and optional coverages are excluded.)

The accident must be reported to the police or to the insurer of the vehicle. When you need to use the travel assistance benefit, please contact Member Services for a claim form.

³ Bail Bond coverage is limited by law in some states to \$1,000 in FL, GA, MT, OR, TN; \$500 in CT, MA, NJ, OK, WV, \$300 in AL, AZ; \$200 in AR, IA, ID, KY, LA, MI, MS, NE, NM, OH, PA, TX, WI; \$105 single, \$300 multiple offenses in IL; Bond coverage is not available to residents of Cook County, IL. Bond coverage is not available in Mexico.

⁴ Attorney's Fees benefit is not available to Alabama, California or New York residents.

⁵ Not available to Texas and Nevada residents.

⁶ Not available to Maryland residents.

⁷ Travel Reimbursement Assistance does not apply to parked vehicles,

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breakdowns, or mechanical failures.

Eligibility

Association Motor Plan benefits and services are available to eligible Association Members. Eligible members are covered for travel in vehicles as defined in this manual. The program does not, however, cover non-members who may be driving a member-owned vehicle. "Member", "You", and "Your" refers to all eligible Association plan members. Benefit eligibility is determined at the sole discretion of your association.

Claim Procedures

For road service reimbursement, no claim form is necessary.⁸ Simply mail your **original** paid receipt showing the:

- date of disablement
- driver's name and address
- driver's Membership number
- make and model of disabled vehicle
- amount paid for the service
- service that the garage provided
- name, address, and telephone number of the commercial garage, locksmith, or tow truck that assisted you

For all other claims, please contact Member Services to receive a claim form.

All claim forms must be completed with all necessary information and received by Safe Driver Motor Club, Inc. within 12 months of the accident or loss.⁹ (No time limit for Utah

residents.)

Definition of Vehicle¹⁰

The term "vehicle" refers specifically to a licensed vehicle designed for public highway use, including:

- automobiles
- single rear-axle trucks
- trailers (tire service only)
- motorcycles

⁸ Reimbursement is not available for dispatch service for any amount exceeding the \$125 limit for disablement. Copies or faxes of invoices not accepted. All requests for reimbursement must be submitted within 30 days of disablement.

⁹ The claims language in this document is not part of the Motor Club statutes 36 O.S. 3101 et al.; therefore, the Oklahoma Insurance Department has not reviewed or approved the language regarding claims reporting for emergency services.

In Wisconsin, proof of loss must be submitted as soon as reasonably possible and within one year after the

time required; failure to furnish such notice or proof within the time required does not invalidate or reduce the claim unless it was reasonably possible for the member to meet the time limit.

¹⁰ Dirt bikes, ATVs, UTVs, and commercial vehicles are excluded from the program services.
